Dear Prospective Fellow:

Physicians for Reproductive Health is seeking the next cohort of extraordinary physician-leaders to become Fellows of the Leadership Training Academy Class of 2018.

The goal of the Academy is to cultivate and support emerging leaders in reproductive and sexual health advocacy. Expert instructors in leadership development, communications, policy, and medical education will help the Fellows develop and utilize the necessary skills to become effective, lifelong advocates for reproductive health.

Applications are open to practicing physicians who have completed US residency training in any medical specialty, and foreign medical graduates who will reside and/or practice in the US during the Academy training period. We are actively seeking applicants who are ready and willing to be vocal and visible advocates for abortion in all platforms. Physicians who practice in least access states and/or who come from communities traditionally underrepresented in medicine or specialties underrepresented in reproductive health advocacy will be given priority consideration.

Participation expenses for the Academy include travel, lodging, and meal expenses as well as a \$500 registration fee. A categorical grant will cover these expenses for up to thirty (30) participants. A limited number of scholarships are also available. Admission and funding decisions will be made after the initial application and interview process, and therefore applicants should consider that **they may be asked to cover their own participation expenses**. If costs would create a barrier to participation, applicants should apply for scholarship support.

CME credits via the American Medical Association Physician's Recognition Award (AMA PRA) Category 1 will be earned upon completion of the Academy program.

NEW deadline for applications is **Friday, June 9, 2017**.

Telephone interviews will be scheduled upon receipt of complete applications.

Requirements

For your Academy application to be complete, you are required to agree to the following:

1. Commit to developing the skills and attributes of a model leader who is willing and able to advocate on reproductive health issues, with emphasis on abortion.
2. Have the full support of your direct supervisor to participate in the program, including travel to attend training sessions and time to participate in monthly webinars
3. Attend three in-person meetings:
 - i. **Sunday evening, October 22 – Thursday, October 26, 2017** in Washington, DC
 - ii. **Monday evening, February 26 – Friday, March 2, 2018** in New York, NY
 - iii. **Thursday, May 31, 2018**, Salt Lake City, Utah
4. Participate in six monthly 90-minute webinars, scheduled for the second Tuesday or Thursday of each month at 7:00 pm EST, from November 2017 to June 2018
5. Independently seek and identify for Physicians **at least one** advocacy activity in media, policy, or medical education systems work; or with Physicians staff (or coalition partners') assistance, and participate in at least one opportunity **from each category**
6. Attend at least one state and one federal advocacy event organized by Physicians or our colleague organizations
7. Respond in a timely manner to requests from Physicians to speak to the media and/or write letters to the editor, op-eds, or blog posts
8. Remain engaged in the Academy as a mentor and potential faculty; actively participate in and contribute to the LTA Talk listserv
9. Be prepared to pay a registration fee of \$500 (which includes training materials and most meals) and be responsible for covering your own expenses for travel and lodging. Some scholarships may be available.

2. Ensure that your two letters of recommendation are sent by **email** to Libby Benedict at libby@prh.org. See section IV for further instructions.

You will not be considered an applicant for the Leadership Training Academy until all required documents are received (completed application form, curriculum vitae, and two letters of recommendation).

Once completed applications are received, qualified applicants will participate in a **phone interview**. We will contact you after your submission at which time we may also ask you to complete a Conflict of Interest form.

All applicants will be informed about the status of their application via email no later than **July 21, 2017**.
